

LODGE HILL CAMPSITE RULES

BOUNDARIES

The boundaries of the site are the Lodge Hill Centre drive to the south-east the fences to the north & west. The paddocks to the north and north-west are out of bounds – on no account should the animals be disturbed. The Lodge Hill Centre which is adjacent to the campsite is out of bounds to campers, except by prior arrangement with the Manager of the Centre.

NOISE

Amplifiers, radios, tape recorders and bugles are NOT TO BE USED on the campsite. Small personal radios are restricted to the classroom or tents, which do not disturb the sites generally.

RESTRICT NOISE IN AREAS ADJACENT TO COLEBROOK LANE WHERE PRIVATE HOUSES ARE NEARBY. KEEP THE SITE QUIET AFTER 10.30 P.M.

FIRES

Fires can only be lit in the designated areas:

- (1) Camp fire site, moderate size fires.
- (2) “Dutch” Oven.
- (3) Concrete bases.

Particular care must be taken on the wooded part of the site.

NO PORTABLE STOVES, FIREWORKS OR INFLAMMABLE MATERIALS ARE TO BE TAKEN ON THE CAMPSITE WITHOUT PRIOR CONSENT FROM THE MANAGER

PARKING/TURNING

No parking or driving beyond the single bar gate (next to the cooking shelter), which should be kept shut.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHOULD CARS BE DRIVEN ON TO THE CAMPING FIELD

LITTER

Do not litter the site. Make sure all bins are emptied into the wheeled bin before leaving the site.

DOGS

No dogs (other than guide dogs for the blind) are allowed on the campsite.

CARAVANS

No caravans are allowed on site.

CLASSROOM HUT

The hut is available for academic work, meetings and indoor activities. On no account must cooking take place in the hut and it is not to be used as a dining room.

CAMPING FIELD

The camping field should not be disturbed for any reason. Users will be liable for any damage.

TREES

Do not damage any trees or shrubbery. Users will be liable for any damage.

WARDENS STORE

The Warden's store is out of bounds to campers.

DAMAGES

A returnable deposit cheque will be required on all bookings, upon collection of campsite keys. A charge will be made for staff time if campsite not left as found.

In the event that the hirer cancels the booking the following fees are payable by the hirer:
